### Annual Dues

- indicate how you can volunteer to support SBAA or if you have constraints,
- provide any suggestions on the operation of SBAA,
- **make a check out to SBAA for \$50** for 2011/2012 dues. It is important that you pay by check so you have a record of your dues payment, and then

Dues should be paid by **July 1**. SBAA provides a 60 day grace period allowing you until the end of August to mail your check. Dues mailed after August 31 are considered late and subject to a \$25 late fee in addition to the dues. If we haven't received your dues, we will send you a reminder mid-July and again mid-August.

## **SBAA Activities from July, 2010 – June, 2011**

- Juried 35 new members into SBAA through 2 New Members' ingatherings.
- Held 6 juried shows including 2 at the Faulkner Gallery in August and February, the Maritime Museum in July, July 4 show in La Arcada, the Annual SBAA Benefit Show at Gallery 113 in October for the Cancer Center of Santa Barbara, and our 60<sup>th</sup> Year Celebration Show at the Channing Peake Gallery March 1 through August 19.
- Held 5 non-juried shows including 4 at the Hutton Foundation buildings and our Holiday show at the Faulkner Gallery.
- Gallery 113 held 11 non-juried group shows for SBAA members.
- In March, held the SAF Grandparent's Art Show for students at the Faulkner Gallery.
- Planned 3 workshops for next year.
- In January, awarded a \$2000 scholarship through the Scholarship Fund of Santa Barbara to a high school student.
- In May, awarded \$1000 scholarships to a student from UCSB, SBCC, and Westmont College.
- In May, donated \$2,250 to SBAA's Student Art Fund (SAF) that pays directly for art supplies in Junior and High School classes.
- In July, managed the Semana Nautica Art Show for the Parks & Recreations Department.
- In August, managed the Small Galleries ingathering process for selecting artists for the S.B. Public Library East and West Wings of the Faulkner Gallery.
- In March, managed the Art Show for the S.B. International Orchid Show.
- In April, managed the Fiesta Poster Competition for Old Spanish Days.
- In November, cosponsored the Film Festival at the Jewish Community Center.
- Reintegrated sculpture into our shows.
- Created an SBAA brochure which is enclosed.
