From the SBAA President – Bob Rowley

Happy Holidays to All our Members! If you know of a member who lives alone or might benefit from a visit, please remember them during this season, or drop me a line and I'll try to arrange a visit.

Next Show: We will be showing in the Faulkner again in January. NOTE that the ingathering and the takedown of the holiday show are both on Saturday, December 29th and there will be a critique on Tuesday, January 8th, 6-8pm.

Budget News: In our continuing effort to balance the SBAA budget, the board has taken 2 new steps.

- First, we will no longer include payments with our awards. Juried shows will still have awards, but only a ribbon will be given.
- Second, **from now on, our entry fee for most juried shows will be the same as the Gallery 113 entry fee - \$12 per piece.** When future reviews of our finances show us to be back on solid footing, these changes may be revisited. If anyone is still wondering why such changes are needed, please review the newsletters from December 2006, January, April, May, July, August, and September, 2007. 3D Artists: To encourage our members who produce 3D works to show with us more, we are trying to borrow pedestals for the December 29 ingathering. If having pedestals available brings more 3D works to our shows, we will try and have some made for future use.

Schedule of Shows for 2008: We have a busy show schedule arranged for 2008! We will have 6 shows in the Faulkner (January, March, May, June, July, and December). We will also be at the Cabrillo Pavilion Arts Center in June. We try not to crowd our schedule like this, but we don't get to choose which months we are in the Faulkner or the Cabrillo. We are exploring the idea of the June Cabrillo show being a specialty show of some type. We have a benefit show scheduled in Gallery 113 for November, and the Festival of Art show in the Courthouse garden mid-October. We will also be in the UCSB Faculty club for a 2-month show next November and December. There is a January takedown/ingathering for the Hutton in Goleta in January and probably the next will be in July. The Downtown Hutton shows are not scheduled yet. Lots of shows so we had all better get busy making art!

New SBAA Directories: Our new Directories are now available for pick up in Gallery 113. If you can't pick yours up, it will be mailed to you mid-January. Be sure to read the first couple of pages that give venue locations and contact information. **Jacqui Bravo** created this year's lovely new directory and cut our cost in half saving SBAA \$ 700!
