Distinct styles, essential sense of mystery, strong emotional responses, expressive variety of deeply personal individual and emotional statements.....

Personal perception and individual representation, of vibrant colors to mysterious moods..... Visual representation of the obvious energy of the artist attempting to break out of the mundane. High level of competence, testament to the strength and critical vigor.....

SBAA exhibitions have been dominated by landscape, with so many diverse pieces reflecting on the figure, abstraction, the use of photography, collage, etc. It is clear the perspectives of the members of the art association have expanded.

I look for artists who “speak” with an authentic genuine voice and whose vision is their own.

In conclusion, SBAA members, keep on painting and showing your work. It is true the perspectives of the art association have expanded.

Honorable Mentions went to Jacqui Bravo (watercolor), John Moses (acrylic), Edith Ostern (acrylic), and Jonathan Wall (acrylic). Our thanks to **Barbara McIntyre** who demonstrated Encaustic Painting, the heat method, at our reception on 1st Thursday.

The show will be juried but open to all artists, not just SBAA members. Members wishing to be "Artist of the Month" in Gallery 113 are to contact Manny Lopez by email lopezmanny220@yahoo.com All applicants will be evaluated on the basis of their ability to exhibit on the main wall as the "Artist of the Month" show for the gallery. The ability to properly present a good quantity of work is the main consideration. Exhibit dates will be determined by lottery and will begin with March 2009. The number of months to be booked will be determined by the number of eligible applicants.

Applicants who have not been a "Featured Artist" previously or are otherwise unknown to the committee will be interviewed to determine their eligibility. No jurying of artwork will be conducted. The fee is \$175 due at the time of hanging the exhibition. We will accept emails from interested artists from now through October 1, 2008.
