Festival of Art

The Festival of Art is fast approaching. Now is the time to get ready to enter the show and try for one of the generous awards. This is our juried show in the Sunken Gardens of the Santa Barbara Courthouse (see details on the next page). **The Beaver Family has donated \$ 2,400 in prize money** for us to present on Saturday, October 13, at 4 PM. The main award winners will be chosen by the juror, Susan Savage, Associate Professor of Art at Westmont. The awards will be: 1st prize \$ 1,000, second prize \$ 500, Artists' choice Award \$ 500, and 4 honorable mentions at \$ 100 each! The Artists' Choice award is an award suggested last year: each artist accepted in this show casts one vote for his or her choice of the best art in the show. The piece with the most votes wins.

This show presents the SBAA to many locals who may not attend shows at our other venues, so plan to enter some of your strongest work, have a go at the awards, and let's put on our best show of the year.

Small Gallery Jurying

The library has scheduled the jurying for their 2008 month long shows in the Faulkner East and West, and the Townley Room on **Wednesday, October 17th**. Ingathering will be in the Faulkner from 10-12:30 with pick up 3-4. There is no entry fee and you must bring in 5 works of art that are framed and ready for hanging. The works should be in the same medium and of a similar style. Jewelry and 3 dimensional work are not eligible nor are artists who have shown in one of those venues in 2007. Please spread the word to other artists!

SBAA dues had to be paid & post-marked before August 31st in order to avoid an additional \$25 late fee. Members must have paid their dues in order to enter any SBAA or Gallery 113 show. The mezzanine spaces are upstairs, and the small image space (back) is the alcove to the right in front of the desk. The Small Image area (front) is fully booked for the year. Cost for the mezzanine spaces is \$75 per month and cost for a Small Image space is \$60 per month.

Spaces are available for the following months:

- Mezzanine A: Jan., Feb., May, & Dec.
- Mezzanine B: Jan., Jul., Sep., & Dec.
- Mezzanine C: Jan., Feb., Apr., Jul., Aug., & Sep.
- Mezzanine D: Jan., Apr., & Dec.
- Sculpture Area: Jan. thru May, Jul. thru Sep.
WE NEED SCULPTURES OR 3D ARTISTS!!!
- Small Image area (back): Jan., Mar., Jun., & Aug. thru Oct.

General Guidelines

1. Artists may have up to 3 shows per year in any combination of mezzanine and Small Image spaces.
2. Artists are not allowed to reserve spaces before the scheduling is opened for the succeeding year.
3. Artists can rent space as a group (e.g. any number of artists can rent the mezzanine for a group show) however, for any artists participating, it counts as a show of the three allowed in point number 1 above.
4. Artists who cancel less than a month before their show date are held responsible for 1/2 of the fee and the space is offered to the replacement artist for 1/2 fee. This is because the replacement ends up with insufficient time to get proper publicity.

**** Gallery 113** will combine their show opening reception with the First Thursday event from now on.

**** The Arts Fund of Santa Barbara announces a Call for Entries** for its 19th annual Individual Artists Awards. This year, visual art awards will be offered in:

- Contemporary Abstract Painting
- Solar plate, monotype and monoprint

The winner in each discipline will receive an award of \$2,500. In addition, winners will be granted solo exhibitions at The Arts Fund Gallery.

Jurors for the Contemporary Abstract Painting discipline will be Tony Askew and Jack Mohr. Jurors for Solar Plate will be Siu Zimmerman and Edward Cella.
